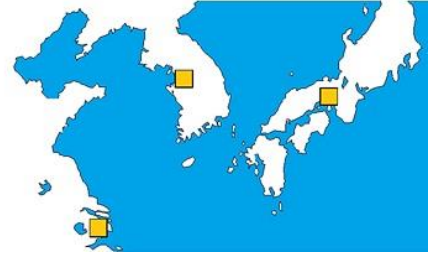

Yasushi Hirosato is a former Professor at the Graduate School of International Development, Nagoya University in Japan, and currently Principal Education Specialist at the Asian Development Bank in the Philippines. His research and professional interests are with educational development and cooperation in developing countries, focusing on education policy and project formulation and implementation, and higher education harmonization and networking in Southeast Asia. He worked at the World Bank, and served as an expert to the Japan International Cooperation Agency and as a senior advisor to the Japan Bank for International Cooperation. He was a Visiting Research Fellow at the Faculty of Economics, Chulalongkorn University in Thailand. He obtained his M.A. from Sophia University in Japan and his Ph.D. from University of Pittsburgh, U.S.A. He received “Cause of Education” Award from the Government of Vietnam in 2006, and “Labor Medal” Award from the Government of Lao PDR in 2010. His major publication include: *The Political Economy for Educational Reforms and Capacity Development in Southeast Asia: Cases of Cambodia, Laos, and Vietnam*.
