Course, in which students are required to take all the necessary credits in two years (or one year). This Course provides lectures of international business law entirely in English. Following are characteristics of the Course. First, in this Course the Internship in foreign law firms (or arbitration institutions) in Asian countries, for 1 to 3 months, is integrated as a compulsory lecture. Second, participation in the moot arbitration competition (ex. FDI Moot, VIS Moot, LawAsia Moot) is also integrated into this Course as optional lectures. The system enables students to join the course for studying both clinical and basic research. Students can also take a crosscutting lab rotation and core lectures offered in English. Students select two areas of specialization, one from basic areas and another from clinical areas, both of which are relevant to the disease. The curriculum enables systematic study of a broad spectrum of specialized knowledge ranging from investigation of basic clinical conditions to development of clinical strategies. We continue to contact alumni who return to their countries, trying to enforce a network for human resource development.</p>
