### **Course enrollment**

The course list for the First/Second Semester is available only from the beginning of August/January and the online course selection begins 2 to 3 weeks prior to the start of semester. We suggest students to make a preliminary plan based on previous course offered and adjust the plan when the latest course list is available. For questions regarding to a specific field/course, please contact the relevant department or the course instructor directly.

### **Workload Requirements**

NTU requires at least <u>2 courses</u> or <u>4 credits</u> per semester for exchange students. Besides, students should follow the requirements of their home universities.

#### **Restricted Courses**

- 1. Practice and Internship courses in the College of Medicine
- 2. The Department of Anthropology (only if students with Chinese language proficiency)
- 3. GMBA courses are not opened for exchange students.

In order to follow NTU courses taught in **English** or **Chinese**, students should have <u>B1 level</u> for <u>English</u> or <u>Chinese</u> Language Proficiency according to the CEFR (<u>Common European Framework of</u> <u>Reference</u>). We trust our partner's selection, so it is not required to provide a language certificate.

#### Chinese language courses
