Procedures at the local municipal office

(Submitting Notification-of-Moving-in/ Enrolling to National Health Insurance and National pension plan)

Please complete the necessary procedures at the local city wards after the 14 days self-isolation period.

[Notification of Move-in Form (Residence registration)]

Those who have a student visa with a permission of at least six months must file a notification of their new address with their Residence Card within 14 days after moving. However, due to the spread of the new coronavirus infection, this restriction will be eased.

[National Health Insurance]

The National Health Insurance System in Japan is an insurance system to reduce individuals' medical costs. International students who reside in Japan must become a member of the National Health Insurance scheme. After joining the system, you will need to pay only 30% of the incurred medical costs.

Registration procedures are carried out at the city/ward office, after submitting Notification of Moving-in (Residence registration). During the period from your arrival date until the date of submitting the national health insurance application, you will be required to bear the full amount of the medical costs. However, you can claim a refund for the 70% of copayment later.

[Notice from Kobe city ward]

From March to April, Kobe ward offices and branch offices tend to be very crowded for procedures such as moving-in and out.

We appreciate your kind cooperation in avoiding congregating at the office, avoiding going from noon to early afternoon, in order to help preventing the spread of the Novel Coronavirus. At this website, you can how many people waiting in line at the office. Please check beforehand.
