- 1) Japanese language courses offered by the Global Education Center (GEC) are open to all exchange students regardless of their affiliation.
Please select "Center for International Education/Global Education Center" in the Department field if you look up courses.
- 2) The following courses are not open to exchange students:
 - Courses offered by the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences
 - Courses for Teaching Credentials
 - Courses offered by the Faculty of Intercultural Studies
 - Courses offered by the Faculty of Human Development

- 3) The School of Medicine (undergraduate level) is NOT open to exchange students.
- 4) The following types of courses offered by the Faculty of Oceanology and the Graduate School of maritime Sciences are not open to exchange students:
 - Experiment
 - Practicum
 - Tutorial
- 5) SESAMI courses (English-taught Business courses) are for degree-seeking students and are subject to limited availability.

Semester: (Quarter system is used in some courses)

Spring: Choose from 1st semester (April - August),
1st quarter (April - June) or 2nd quarter (June - August).
Fall: Choose from 2nd semester (October - February),
3rd quarter (October - December) or 4th quarter (December - February).

Classroom Language:

Many faculties (schools) /graduate schools offer courses only in Japanese. To find English-taught courses, select 'English' in the classroom language column.
