

Diploma Policy of the Faculty of Economics

The Faculty of Economics at Kobe University is dedicated to education and research fostering rich humanity through inheriting and developing creatively the human knowledge on the economy and society. The goal of the Faculty is to educate students to possess a high level of logical thinking and expertise in economics and a wide range of related academic fields, together with a broad knowledge and a spirit of cooperation, enabling them to respond to various demands to identify and solve problems arising in a globalized society.

In order to achieve these objectives, we award bachelor's degree under the following principles.

Degree: Bachelor of Economics

The Faculty of Economics awards this degree under the principles stated below, based on the university's Diploma Policy and the spirit of "Sincerity, Freedom, and Cooperation" that has existed since the period of Kobe Higher Commercial School.

1. Students must be enrolled in the Faculty for the designated period of time and obtain the required credits.
2. By the time of graduation, students are expected to acquire the following abilities in addition to those specified in the university's Diploma Policy:
 - The ability to think logically and mathematically.
 - The ability to analyze accurately and elucidate phenomena in society.
 - The ability to synthesize and accurately express the results of analysis and elucidation.
