Diploma Policy of the Graduate School of Business Administration

Master's Program

Degree: Master of Arts in Business Administration

- Students shall study at the graduate school for the designated period, obtain the required credits for completion, and pass the examinations prescribed by the graduate school.
- Prior to completion, in addition to the abilities prescribed in Kobe University's Diploma Policy, students shall acquire advanced expertise in academic fields related to business administration and accounting, and master scientific research methodologies.

Degree: Master of Arts in Commerce

- Students shall study at the graduate school for the designated period, obtain the required credits for completion, and pass the examinations prescribed by the graduate school.
- Prior to completion, in addition to the abilities prescribed in Kobe University's Diploma Policy, students shall acquire advanced expertise in academic fields related to commerce, and master scientific research methodologies.

Doctoral Program

Degree: Doctor of Philosophy in Business Administration

- Students shall study at the graduate school for the designated period, obtain the required credits for completion, and pass the examinations prescribed by the graduate school.
- Prior to completion, in addition to the abilities prescribed in Kobe University's Diploma Policy, students shall acquire the ability to conduct creative, original research based on their advanced expertise in academic fields related to business administration and accounting, and their knowledge of scientific research methodologies.

Degree: Doctor of Philosophy in Commerce

- Students shall study at the graduate school for the designated period, obtain the required credits for completion, and pass the examinations prescribed by the graduate school.
- Prior to completion, in addition to the abilities prescribed in Kobe University's Diploma Policy, students shall acquire the ability to conduct creative, original research based on their advanced expertise in academic fields related to commerce, and their knowledge of scientific research methodologies.

Professional Degree Program

Degree: Master of Business Administration

- Students shall study at the graduate school for the designated period, obtain the required credits for completion, and pass the examinations prescribed by the graduate school.
- Prior to completion, students shall acquire the following abilities in addition to those
 prescribed in Kobe University's Diploma Policy; advanced expertise in general business
 administration, deep specialized knowledge in specific fields of business administration,
 logical thinking and the ability to apply this to real situations, and the thinking,
 judgement and communication skills necessary to be recognized by the international
 community.
