Scholarship	Sato Yo International Scholarship Foundation for Autumn 2021 (No.70)
Eligibility	<p>As of October 2021 or April 2022, <u>a new student</u> who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> (Undergraduate) transfers to the university (Graduate) is on a Master's course or Doctoral course. <input type="checkbox"/> is not of Japanese nationality. <input type="checkbox"/> will be registered as a regular student from Bangladesh, Bhutan, Brunei, Cambodia, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, the Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, the Philippines, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Thailand, East Timor or Vietnam. (Non-regular students such as research students are not eligible.) <input type="checkbox"/> does not have a parent working in Japan. <input type="checkbox"/> does not hold any doctorate degree. <input type="checkbox"/> has more than 1 year until completion of their courses. <input type="checkbox"/> has the sufficient Japanese language skills required for their studies and research. <input type="checkbox"/> is highly interested in cross-cultural exchanges and social contribution. <input type="checkbox"/> is able to attend an exchange event held by Sato Yo International Scholarship Foundation (which is held 6 times in a year, mainly in Tokyo.) <input type="checkbox"/> is able to take part in exchange and networking activities as a graduate of the foundation after completing the scholarship period.
Monthly Stipend	<p>Undergraduate: 150, 000 yen Graduate: 180, 000 yen (A subsidy for attending the association meeting is provided.) (Undergraduate and Graduate: There is a subsidy system for tuition (not applicable to students who have been granted a full tuition exemption.)</p>
Period	<p>For 2 years (the shortest required period for course completion)</p> <p>※ Doctoral course students: will receive the scholarship during the shortest period until completion (4 years for medical students, 3 years for other disciplines). However, if it is determined that students who have received the scholarship for more than 2 years cannot obtain their doctorate during the shortest period, the payment may be discontinued.</p>
