

Summer Down Under Research Internship

What is a UWA Research Internship?

Under the guidance of a UWA supervisor, you will participate in a research project, working closely with postdocs and postgraduate students from a research group as a fullyfledged member of the team. You may have the opportunity to contribute to a publication or grant application.

You will also participate in a range of curated events and training sessions to help launch your research career, including:

You will receive a certificate of participation upon completion of the program.

Student Eligibility

- High performing "research ready" 3rd-4th year undergraduate or Masters students
- English proficiency for non-native speakers (generally IELTS 6.5 or <u>equivalent</u>)
 - Students with an IELTS of 5.5 or 6.0 may be considered on a case-bycase basis if undertaking an optional English language program
- Expressed interest in undertaking a UWA higher degree by research program (i.e. MSc, PhD)

Student Assessment

- Completion of three online units: <u>ACE</u>, <u>CARS</u> and <u>ISE</u>
- Project presentation in a Three Minute Thesis (3MT[®]) format
- Σupervisor feedback to Coordinator
- ▶ Ungraded pass/fail awarded

Summer Down Under Research Internship Application Timeline

1 February:

Projects available for student selection through website and their university coordinator. Students may contact their potential supervisors to understand more about the project (not to discuss acceptance).

28 February:

Deadline for applications.

1 April:

Our Global Engagement Office will contact you to confirm the outcome of your application.

Optional English language programs

Option 1

Summer Down Under intensive IELTS Examination preparation program:

- Five-week program (at 15 hours per week)
- Run concurrently with Summer Down Under Research Internship program
- IELTS test can be taken at course completion.

Option 2

This will benefit students whose English level is below IELTS 6.5. To be run prior to the Summer Down Under Research Internship program

UWA CELT Bridging Course:

• 10 or 20 week direct English pathway
