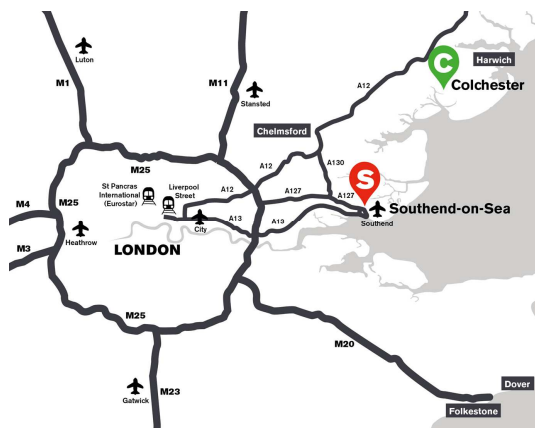

- **International Commercial and Business Law:** taught by our School of Law - Essex is ranked 13th for Law in the UK in THE World University Rankings (2021)
- **Python for Data Science:** taught by our School of Computer Science and Electronic Engineering - ranked 27th in the UK for Computer Science and Information Systems in the QS World University Rankings by Subject (2021).

SOCIAL PROGRAMME

We've put together a full programme of inclusive extracurricular activities to help you make the most of your time in England. During your two weeks with us, you'll get involved with the following activities:

▪ Colchester

Explore the oldest recorded town in the UK and former capital of Roman Britain, learning about its history over 1000 years with a walking tour from a local expert. Afterwards, you'll have the evening to check out the best places to eat and drink and get to know your new home. Why not check out the Castle, dating back to Norman England, wander our medieval cobbled streets and see where Humpty Dumpty fell off the wall during the Civil War? (Plot twist: Humpty Dumpty wasn't an egg...)

▪ Dedham

Get to know Essex's famous countryside, home of the artist John Constable, with a relaxing walk through stunning rural landscapes and sip a cool drink afterwards in a pub dating back to the 1400s.

▪ Southend

Like the beach? We do too! Enjoy an ice cream on the longest pleasure pier in Europe, try your hand at an arcade and take home a traditional stick of rock (candy) – just remember your sun cream.

▪ Warner Bros Studio Tour London: The Making of Harry Potter

Discover the magic of the Wizarding World with a trip to the Warner Bros studios where Harry Potter was filmed. Go behind the scenes and explore the sets, get up close with magical creatures – and wear your house colours with pride!

▪ Colchester Zoo

Visit over 200 species from Aardvarks to Zebras at Colchester's own award-winning Zoo (2021 Trip Advisor Travellers Choice Award) – as the largest private zoo in the UK with over 60 acres of parkland and lakes, there's plenty to discover.

▪ London
