

○ Regulations on the Amounts of Tuition, Admission and Entrance Examination Fees and Accommodation Fees at Kobe University

(Purpose)

Article 1 The purpose of these Regulations is to provide for necessary matters concerning the amounts of tuition, admission and entrance examination fees, and accommodation fees at the Kobe University (hereinafter referred to as the "University"), pursuant to the provisions of Article 52 of the National University Corporation Kobe University Accounting Regulations (established on April 1, 2004).

(Amounts of Tuition, Admission and Entrance Examination Fees)

Article 2 The amounts of tuition fees (or childcare fees in the case of the kindergarten; the same shall apply hereinafter), admission fees (or kindergarten enrollment fees in the case of the kindergarten; the same shall apply hereinafter), and entrance examination fees charged by the University are set forth in the following table:

2 The annual amount of tuition fees collected from a person who has obtained approval, pursuant to the provisions of Article 22, paragraph 4 of the Kobe University Academic Regulations (hereinafter referred to as "Academic Regulations") (including cases where applied mutatis mutandis pursuant to Article 72 of the Academic Regulations), to systematically complete the curriculum over a certain period beyond the years required for completion of course of study or the standard years required for completion of course of study of the University and thereby graduate or complete the program shall, notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraph, and only during the approved period of enrollment (hereinafter referred to as "Period of Long-Term Enrollment"), be calculated by dividing the amount obtained by multiplying the annual tuition fees specified in the same paragraph by the number of years corresponding to the years required for completion of course of study or the

standard years required for completion of course of study of the University, by the number of years of the Period of Long-Term Enrollment. (Any remainder of less than 10 yen shall be rounded up.)

- 3 In cases where screening is conducted at the faculty level based on application documents and other related materials (hereinafter referred to as the "First-Stage Screening") and only applicants who pass the First-Stage Screening are further screened by academic achievement tests or other means (hereinafter referred to as the "Second-Stage Screening"), the amounts of the entrance examination fees shall, notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 1, be 4,000 yen for the First-Stage Screening, and 13,000 yen for the Second-Stage Screening.
- 4 In cases where the First-Stage Screening is conducted at the Department of Professional Legal Studies of the Graduate School of Law and only applicants who pass the First-Stage Screening are further screened in the Second-Stage Screening, the amounts of the entrance examination fees shall, notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 1, be 7,000 yen for the First-Stage Screening, and 23,000 yen for the Second-Stage Screening.
- 5 At the Elementary School, Lower Course of the Secondary School, and the Elementary and Lower Secondary Divisions of the School for Special Needs Education, the amounts of entrance examination fees collected when examinations, health checks, screening based on documents and other related materials, and other screening are conducted for admission shall be as specified in the following table.

- 6 Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 1 and the preceding paragraph, with respect to the entrance examination fees in cases where screening for admission to the Kindergarten, the Upper Course of the Secondary School, and the Upper Secondary Division of the School for Special Needs Education referred to in paragraph 1, and to the Elementary School, the Lower Course of the Secondary School, and the Elementary and Lower Secondary Divisions of the School for Special Needs Education referred to in the preceding paragraph involves a lottery or other similar method (hereinafter referred to as "examinations, etc." in this paragraph), the fees for screening by lottery shall be as specified in column 2 of the following table, and the fees for examinations, etc. shall be as specified in column 3 of the same table.

- 7 The amount of the entrance examination fee for transfer between faculties, transfer admission from another university or college, or re-admission shall, notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 1, be 30,000 yen. However, in cases where the First-Stage Screening is conducted in relation to transfer admission and only applicants who pass the First-Stage Screening are further screened in the Second-Stage Screening, the amounts of the entrance examination fees shall be 7,000 yen for the First-Stage Screening, and 23,000 yen for the Second-Stage Screening.

- 8 The amount of tuition fees for a person admitted by transfer admission, transfer between faculties, or re-admission shall be the same as the tuition fees for students enrolled in the same academic year as the said person.
- 9 The amount of tuition fees for a person who completes the Master's Program at a graduate school pursuant to the provisions of the proviso of Article 16 of the Standards for the Establishment of Graduate Schools (Order of the Ministry of Education, Science and Culture No. 28 of 1974) and immediately advances to the graduate school's Doctoral Program of the University shall be the same as the tuition fees for students enrolled in the same academic year as the said person.

(Amounts of Accommodation Fees)

Article 3 The amounts of accommodation fees charged by the University shall be as specified in the following table.

- 2 In addition to those provided in this Article, necessary matters pertaining to the amounts of accommodation fees shall be set forth separately.

Supplementary Provisions

These Regulations shall come into effect on April 1, 2004.

Supplementary Provisions between the original and the latest are omitted.

Supplementary Provisions (March 24, 2020)

These Regulations shall come into effect on April 1, 2020.
