

Lesson period of Semester (Quarter system is used in some courses):

Lesson Period in Spring: Choose from 1st semester (April - August),

1st quarter (April - June) 2nd quarter (June - August).

Lesson Period in Fall: Choose from 2nd semester (October - February),

3rd quarter (October - December) 4th quarter (December - February).

Classroom Language:

Many Faculties (Schools) /Graduate Schools offer courses only in Japanese. To find English-taught courses, select 'English' in the Classroom Language field.
