

Bachelor's Degree Program : Kobe University

Recognizing its inherent mission and social, historical, and regional roles, Kobe University has established the Kobe University Charter on Education in order to fulfill the responsibilities entrusted to it by the public. Based on this charter, the University has established the following policy for conferring bachelor's degrees.

1. Kobe University sets the acquisition of Humanity, Creativity, International Awareness, and Expertise as the common aim of learning for all students, and its goal is to have students acquire the following virtues.

- High ethics and a rich education based on a balance of intellect, reason, and sensitivity (Humanity)
- The ability to set their own tasks and solve them creatively, while critically inheriting traditional thinking and methodologies (Creativity)
- Respect for diverse values, a deep understanding of other cultures, and excellent communication skills supporting these attitudes (International Awareness)
- A profound knowledge and advanced professional skills that enable them to take on leadership roles in their respective professions and fields of study (Expertise)

2. Kobe University confers a bachelor's degree upon those who have graduated from the University after completing the prescribed undergraduate coursework.
