- The ability to think logically and mathematically.
- The ability to analyze accurately and elucidate phenomena in society.
- The ability to synthesize and accurately express the results of analysis and elucidation.

2. The Faculty's graduation requirement for the conferring of the Bachelor of Economics is to attend Kobe University for the prescribed period of time, to acquire the credits stipulated in the University's rules for the Faculty, and to achieve the learning goals set by the University and the Faculty.
