

Faculty of Medicine, Kobe University School of Medicine aims to provide broad knowledge, conduct education and research in the fields of medicine and life sciences, and equip students with advanced specialized knowledge and skills. Its objective is to train physicians with a perspective as "scientists," possessing a high sense of ethics, a strong spirit of inquiry, and creativity, as well as researchers who promote cutting-edge and interdisciplinary research in medicine and life sciences. Furthermore, Faculty of Medicine aims to foster researchers with a broad perspective who will become leaders in their respective fields and contribute on an international stage.

To achieve these educational objectives, the Faculty establishes the following policies regarding the conferral of the Doctor of Medicine, based on the degree conferral policy set by Kobe University.

1. The School establishes the learning objectives for the Faculty of Medicine has set its learning goal in the School of Medicine as acquiring the following abilities in addition to the virtues prescribed by the University's policy on conferring degrees.

- The ability to build good relationships with patients, healthcare professionals, and others. (Courtesy and attitude)
- A sense of inquiry and sensitivity towards life sciences, along with scientific thinking abilities and creativity. (Scientific curiosity)
- A well-balanced knowledge of both basic and clinical sciences, with accurate clinical reasoning abilities. Understanding pathological conditions and acquiring the necessary basic skills related to them. (Knowledge and skills)
- A solid ethical stance, with the ability to continuously transform oneself in collaboration with others. (Ethics)
- The ability to set personal goals, identify issues, and work toward their resolution. A strong desire to become a valuable individual with a long-term perspective. (Ambition)
- The ability to accept diversity, exhibit leadership, and contribute to the community. (Leadership)
- The ability to collect and analyze a wide range of information, engage in appropriate discussions, and possess the language skills and international outlook necessary for such activities. (Internationality)

2. The School's graduation requirement for the conferring of the Bachelor of Medicine degree is to attend Kobe University for the prescribed period of time, to acquire the credits stipulated in the University's rules for the Faculty of Medicine, to achieve the learning goals, set by both Kobe University and the Faculty, and pass the graduation examination.
