Master's Program

Degree: Master of Maritime Science and Technology

Based on the Kobe University Diploma Policy, the Master of Maritime Sciences qualification is awarded in accordance with the policy shown below.

- Students shall study the graduate school’s master’s program for at least two years, and obtain the required credits for graduation prescribed by the graduate course.

- Prior to graduation, students of the graduate school are expected to acquire the following abilities in addition to those set out in the Kobe University Diploma Policy:

- Communication skills
- Thinking abilities based on scientific logic
- Develop specialized knowledge
- The ability to write reports and make presentations
- Specialized knowledge

Doctoral Program

Degree: Doctor of Philosophy in Maritime Science and Technology

Based on the Kobe University Diploma Policy, the Doctor of Philosophy in Maritime Sciences qualification is awarded in accordance with the policy shown below.

- Students shall study the graduate school’s doctoral program for at least three years, and obtain the required credits for graduation prescribed by the graduate course.

- Students shall conduct highly specialized research related to maritime and ocean affairs.
- In addition to the abilities stipulated in the Kobe University Diploma Policy, graduate students should acquire the following competences by the time they complete the program:
 - The ability to come up with highly original and creative research themes.
 - The ability to plan and execute research.
 - Thinking abilities based on scientific logic.
 - Development and application of specialized knowledge.
 - The ability to write reports and make presentations.
 - Specialized knowledge.

Degree: Doctor of Philosophy in Engineering

Based on the Kobe University Diploma Policy, the Doctor of Philosophy in Engineering qualification is awarded in accordance with the policy shown below.

- Students shall study at the graduate school's doctoral program for at least three years, and obtain the required credits for graduation prescribed by the graduate course.
- Acquire the ability to conduct highly specialized research related to engineering.
- In addition to the abilities stipulated in the Kobe University Diploma Policy, graduate students should acquire the following competences by the time they complete the program:
 - The ability to come up with highly original and creative research themes.
 - The ability to plan and execute research.
 - Thinking abilities based on scientific logic.
 - Development and application of specialized knowledge.
 - The ability to write reports and make presentations.
 - Specialized knowledge.

Degree: Doctor of Philosophy
